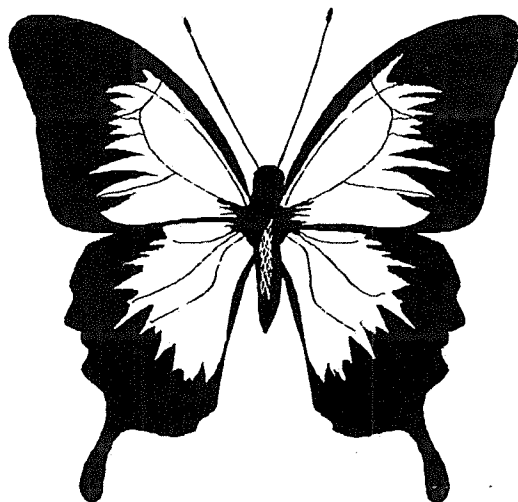


Koinonia of Jamestown



Koinonia Vocabulary

CANDIDATE: One who is making the Koinonia weekend.

CURSILLO (cur-see-yo): Abbreviation of Cursillo de Cristiandad, or short course in Christianity; the Roman Catholic Movement which originated in Spain in 1949 and which is the basis for Koinonia.

CURSILLESTA (cur-see-ess-tah): one who has made a Cursillo weekend.

DE COLORES (day koh-lor-ehs): Of "Colors" or "Many colors" or "Brightly Colored". Used as a greeting by Cursillestas.

EMBRAZZO: Literally a hug; used to describe the traditional Christian Greeting, the brotherly embrace.

FOURTH DAY: All the days in the lifetime of a Koinonian following the three day weekend.

GROUP REUNION: A group of 3 - 6 Koinonians who gather regularly to share their piety, study and action and to help each other persevere.

LAS MANANITAS (mahn-yah-nee-tahs): Literally, a little good morning, a morning serenade.

PALANCA (pah-lahn-kah): Literally, a lever of influence, an expression of love through self giving or sacrifice.

RECTOR: The head of a Koinonia team; used in the academic sense of the head of a student body as opposed to the clerical sense

REUNION GROUPS: A monthly community gathering of Koinonians.

SPONSOR: A Koinonian who recruits another person to go on a weekend.

ULTREYA: (ool-tray-ah): A community gathering of Koinonians.
