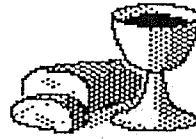


The Chalices



There were two chalices created for the Koinonia Community of Jamestown, Chautauqua County, New York. The larger of the two chalices is made from apple wood. It was offered as "palanca" by the K-1 Team, and was totally hand crafted by a member of the K-1 Team. Carved into the wood near the top of the chalice is our scriptural theme from the Gospel of John.

The smaller hand crafted chalice is made of porcelain with the Koinonian Community symbols applied to it in blue porcelain. This treasure was offered to the Community by a potter in Jamestown, New York.
